

Test & Examination

The School believes in all round development of the student, and does not advocate a highly pressurized, tension filled result oriented system of education. However, at the same time., It is imperative to develop a competitive spirit in the child to face the challenges of the modern world. For this regular tests and examinations are an important medium to find out their leave of achievement.

They also assist the teachers to find out the weak areas and this helps them to direct their energies towards fruitful endeavor. Monthly test and periodic examinations are held to asses the child's ability and academic excellence.

Examination

Dinapur Public School functions on two terminal (i.e. H.Y. & Annual) and four unit test examination (i.e. PA-I PA-II PA-III & PA-IV) system. The first term examination commences in the month of September and second term examination is concluded in the month of March.

As the CBSE affiliated schools are required to follow the NCERT syllabus in the upper primary stage, uniformity in the assessment structure, examination and issue of report cards across all the affiliated schools is felt necessary from class VI to VIII. The detail components of the scheme are mentioned below for easy understanding and implementation.

Co-Scholastic Activities (Classes VI–VIII):

For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas be carried out in CBSE affiliated schools by the teacher and will be graded term-wise on a 3 point grading scale (A=Outstanding, **B=Very Good** and **C=Fair**). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork be the generic criteria for grading in the following coscholastic activities:

Discipline (Classes VI-VIII):

The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance sincerity, behavior,

values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others, Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3 point grading scales

(A = Outstanding, B =Very Good and C = Fair




From of Disciplinary Measures
